ROLE SUMMARY.

The purpose of your role is a vital one in Christchurch United Football Club. You will be required to deal with various injuries that occur during training and match days. You will need to monitor these injuries and communicate with players, parents and the Centre Manager regarding the injury and the rehabilitation process following this.

Our aim is to reduce the number of injuries we see during team training and match days. You will have a role in this by developing Injury Prevention Programmes for players and age groups where necessary.

MAIN DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES.

- To administer immediate first aid treatment to all CUFC registered players
- To coordinate with Players, Parents, Academy Director and Age Group Coach regarding players need during and throughout the injury period including rehabilitation
- To provide treatment and rehabilitation to all injured athletes
- To keep up to date medical records
- To liaise with the Academy Director and Age Group Coach to ensure players needs are met to continue continuous professional development in their field and to maintain current insurance
- To work with the First Team Physio on planning and delivering sport science programmes during training
- This role does involve training, supervising, working with and/or being in sole charge of children and young people

QUALIFICATION, SKILLS and EXPERIENCE

- BSc degree in Sports Therapy/Physiotherapy or currently studying
 - Strength and conditioning qualification preferred
 - Enjoy working with children
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- Good recording and reporting skills
- Good level of communication and listening skills
- Calm under pressure
- Proven ability to maintain confidentiality
- Excellent and up to date understanding of Child Protection and Safeguard procedures and relevant clearance.
- Possess computer literacy, including the ability to work with standard word-processing (Word, Excel, and PowerPoint) tools
